

McFarland Youth Football-issued Required Equipment

Must be returned in good condition at the end of the season

Damage beyond normal wear will be your responsibility

Helmet	• MYF issues a Riddell Victor-I or Speed Flex helmet • MYF-approved decals will be provided for all helmets • Do not adjust or modify the issued helmet in any way	
Shoulder Pads	• MYF issues Riddell NOCSAE-compliant shoulder pads • Do not modify the shoulder pads in any way - this includes attaching back pads	
Practice Jersey	• Must be worn over shoulder pads at all practices • Wash in cold and hang dry - do not place in a dryer	
(2) Game Jerseys	• Worn for games only • Navy (Home), White (Away) • Wash in cold and hang dry - do not place in a dryer	
Practice Pants	• Worn for practices only • Wash in cold and hang dry - do not place in a dryer	
Game Pants	• Worn for practices only • Wash in cold and hang dry - do not place in a dryer	
Mouthguard	• MYF issues a basic mouthguard with a strap to be attached to the helmet facemask • If you buy your own it must have a strap to attach to the helmet facemask and cannot be clear	

Required Equipment - Player Purchase

Football Cleats	• Must be molded rubber - no metal spikes • Must not be for another sport (soccer, baseball, etc)	
Socks	• Sock color must match uniform on game day	
Water Jug/Cooler	• At minimum must be a half gallon to 1-gallon size • Coaches do not bring water or water bottles to practice • Every player must have sufficient water for every practice regardless of weather forecast
